Neighbourhood Park	Neighbourhood parks are intended to serve the immediate park and recreational needs of people in a neighbourhood planning area through the provision of active and passive recreational opportunities. Neighbourhood parks also include tot lots, parkettes and other small parks and open space areas.
Community Park	Community parks are intended to provide a range of outdoor and indoor recreational opportunities to a population base of approximately 20,000 persons. Community parks are primarily intended to accommodate active sports and recreational activities but may also include areas for passive recreation.
City Park	City parks are intended to serve residents throughout the City of Oshawa through the provision of major park and recreational opportunities or cultural facilities, that perform a distinctive function on a City-wide basis. City parks may also be established to preserve natural features such as scenic vistas, creek valleys, the lakefront and other areas.
